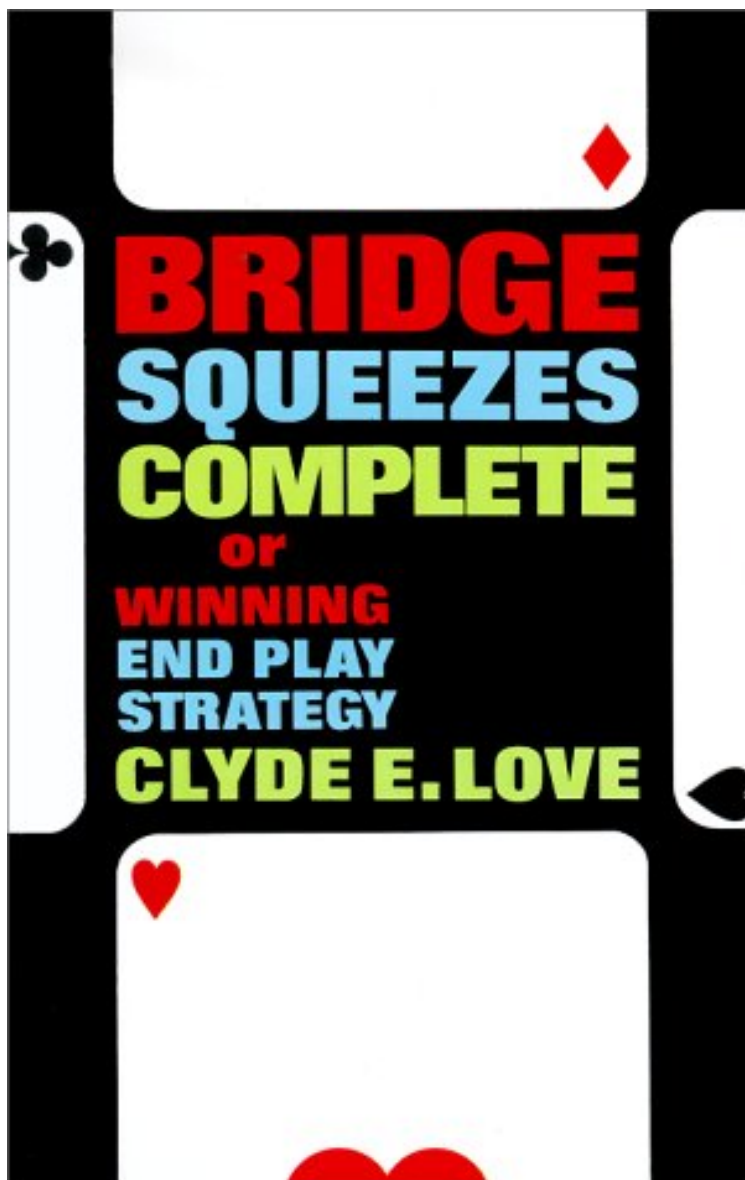

If you read this book thoroughly it will improve your game tremendously. The bidding in it is antiquated and it is written as a very dense textbook, but the declarer play is incredible. Love describes in detail all the different kinds of squeezes and how to execute them. He has detailed examples for you to work through, and then problems for you to try on your own before looking at the answers. His coverage of strip squeezes was a bit confusing, but he covers simple, double, and compound squeezes wonderfully (he covers more exotic squeezes, too). However, I wish he had discussed defending against squeeze plays more (it was only mentioned briefly). This book is not for the beginner or casual player, but it's fantastic if you're serious about bridge.

The bidding is sometimes quaint, the style oftentense, but "the play's the thing"... If you're an intermediate or advanced player, and willing to work some things out from terse summaries (a great way to fix learning into your mind, much better than having it spoonfed to you!), this great classic book will offer you hours of entertaining self-improvement: a little theory, a lot of hands to practice it on. Simple squeezes are perhaps treated a bit cursorily; endplays may be better covered elsewhere. But double squeezes have never been better explained anywhere else, despite this book's venerable age, and the treatment of strip-squeezes, triple squeezes, and compound squeezes, is still among the best. A book you will re-read, and appreciate more deeply, as your understanding of card play grows and ripens in time.
