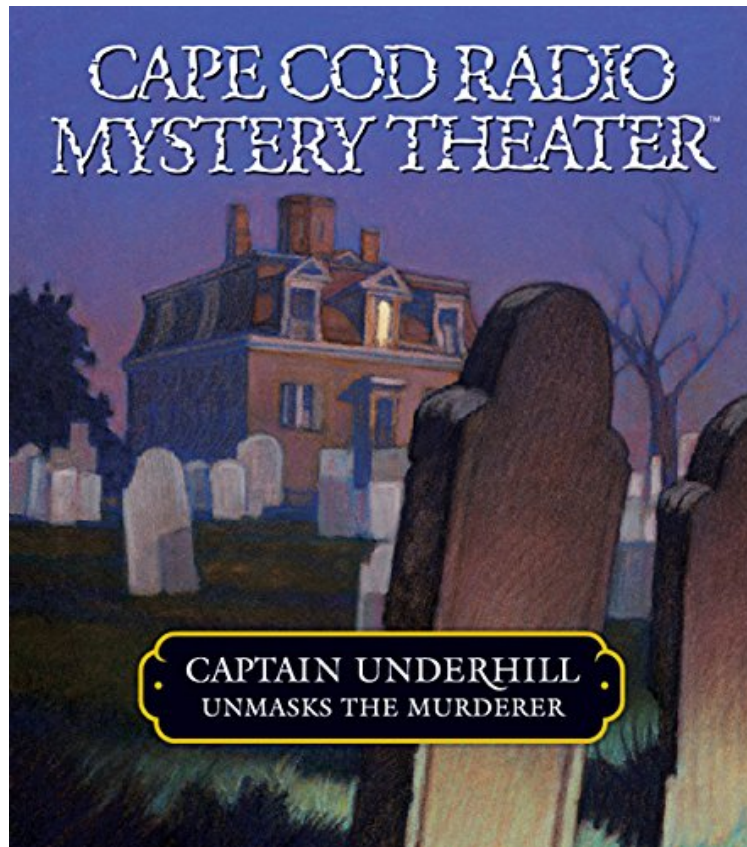

The first 75% of the program is all build-up with references back to "The Legacy...", the next 20% is something of a storyline, albiet rather slow and uninteresting, and then...BOOM!! - the story is over.
