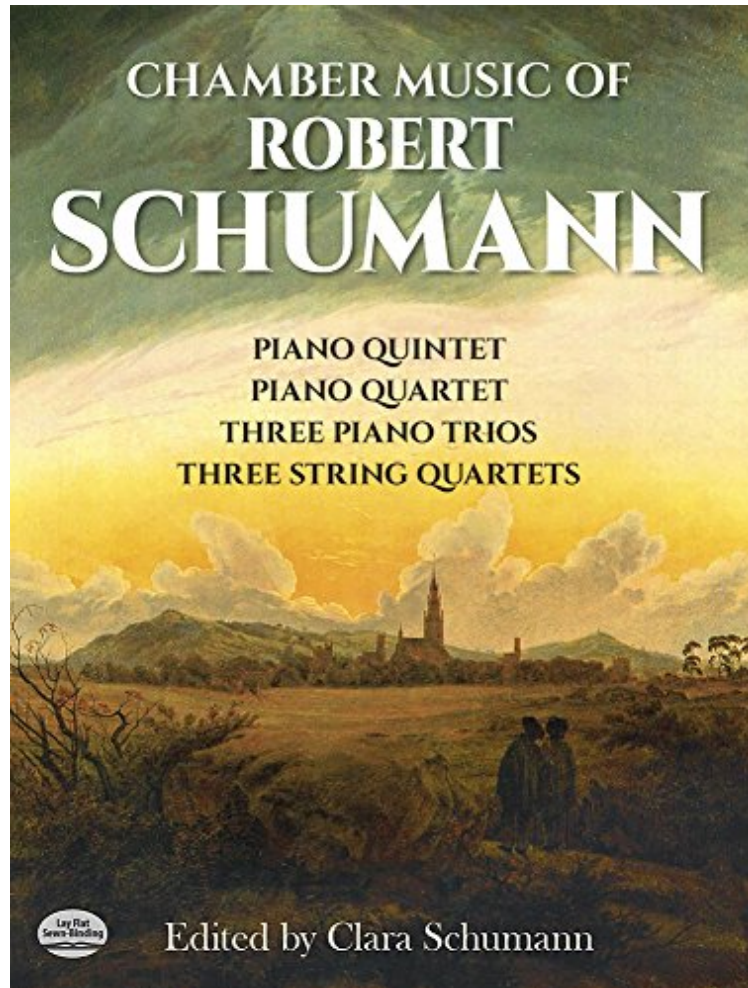

It is a great study-score; as a performance score, the only downside is the lack of parts (which can be photocopied). The famous Piano Quintet, the Quartet, the three trios and three string quartets cover a vast range of moods; the

The Schumann Chamber music is appeasingly romantic, while not going over board. These pieces are extremely fun to play, as well as listen to!

Schumann's chamber music embraces three trios, four quartets, and a piano quartet that have, on the whole, received enthusiastic acclaim. The trios have passages and whole movements of great spirit that are characteristic of the composer's best work. The quartets have engraved themselves deep in the minds of all music lovers, and the piano quartet is considered one of the finest such pieces ever written. These eight works have been arranged as follows in this volume: Quintet in E-flat Major, Op. 44; Quartet in E-flat Major, Op. 47; Trio No. 1 in D Minor, Op. 63; Trio No. 2 in F Major, Op. 80; Trio No. 3 in G Minor, Op. 110; String Quartet No. 1 in A Minor, Op. 41, No. 1; String Quartet No. 2 in F Major, Op. 41, No. 2; and String Quartet No. 2 in F Major, Op. 41, No. 3. All lovers of chamber music and of romantic music will find much to enjoy in this superb collection.
