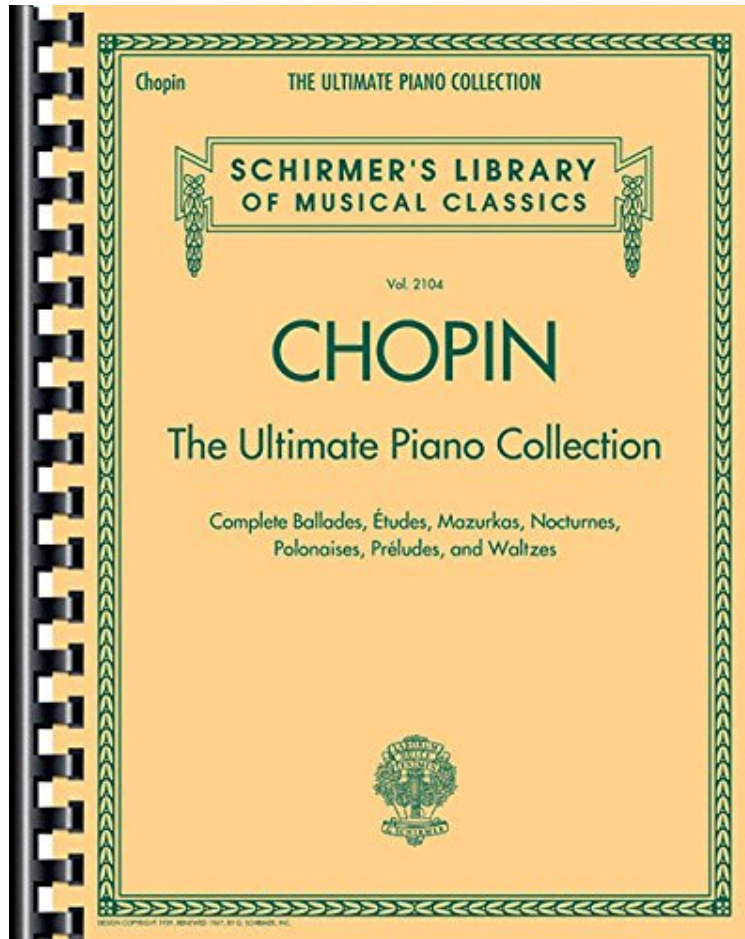

Not-so-good: Its very very big. 728 pages big. If you are playing something near the beginning or near the end of the book (so that much of the book is on one side) it may not sit on your piano music stand.
