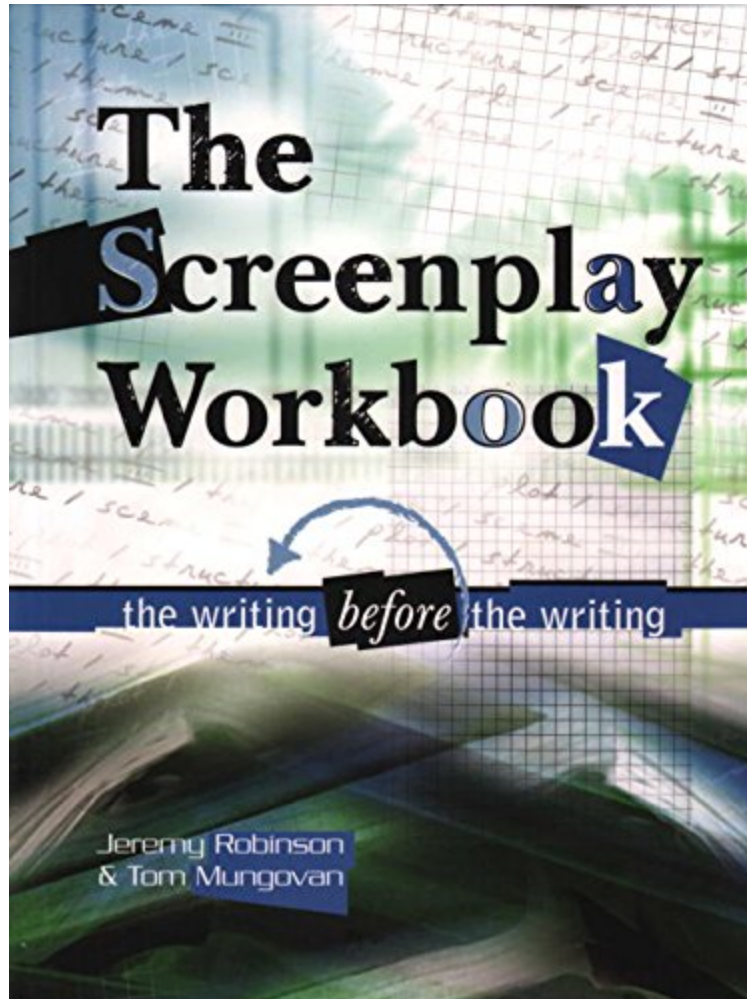

They really aren't something that need to be repeated over and over again to thicken the book, but I do find them helpful. What I don't find very pleasing is the word usage. On page one I believe the writer should know the difference between "then" and "than." Then, I feel the need to re-write the sheets to suit my needs. There's no use for saying that Plot Point #1 should fit on pages 20-30. It might be an okay rule of thumb, but it's not how I would teach it. The good thing about this text as a whole is that someone who wants some structure in their scriptwriting should purchase this book. It's worth it (especially if you can get a decent used copy). I'll give it 3 stars.
