She is Jill Randall, and her 120 page book includes eight chapters and 49 mostly full-page colored photographs. The chapters interweave her story, comedic riffs, her maxims for living, some unusual takes on religion and history, and her varied ways of making a living over the past 35 or so years. Chapter titles?--I'm jilling it--No guts, no glory--It's time to break

thine bread and other bad habits--Re legion, the whole lie babble and the awful beast--Love is EVOL--Armageddon a little tired of this...aren't you?--In the beginning and the middle too--End timesThe photos speak for themselves in establishing what a photogenic blonde we're talking about: See for example, p. 83, of Jill as a 1990 Miss Maryland USA Finalist and as a Victoria's Secret photo shoot model. Trust me: drop dead gorgeous!A few quotes may give the flavor of her straight-talking, adult readers style:"Every bit of politics is a circus...or a rigged donkey and elephant show" (p.54)"Most of my friends were juniors though I did befriend a very large unpopular girl my age...Even her name was kinda creepy.""I shared an apartment on 124" street with a real estate agent in her 40's named Sam. ..She got her heart broken by a longtime boyfriend and she talked about him constantly. Most notably, she gave me a recipe for l**e and told me I should m*st*rb*t* which was a good thing as I was not interested in sleeping around."
