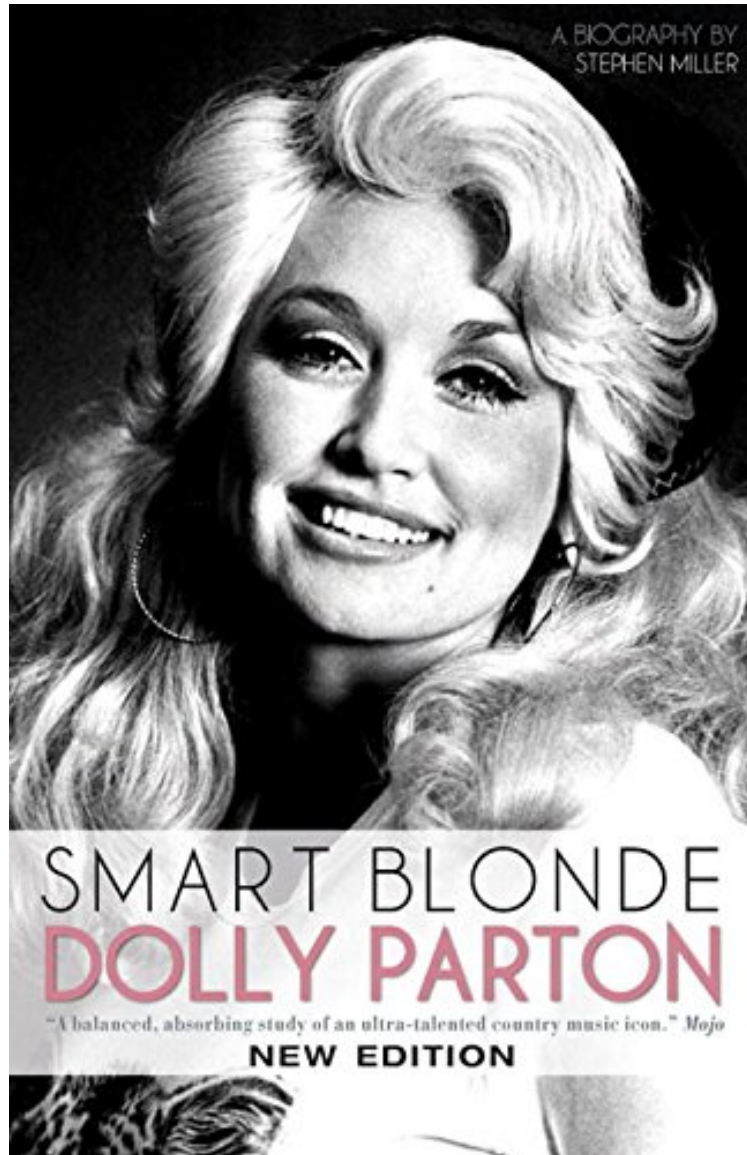

The most honored female country performer of all time, she's known as much for her songwriting as for her sequined outfits, big hair, foxy personality (her words), and her Nashville theme park, Dollywood. Born into poverty in East Tennessee, Dolly got her first guitar at age eight and performed at Pentecostal churches before rising to prominence on The Porter Wagoner Show in 1967. Her career took off from there, and she became a multi-format star, writing and performing pop music as well as country songs, starring in films and musicals, and creating several successful business and charitable enterprises.
