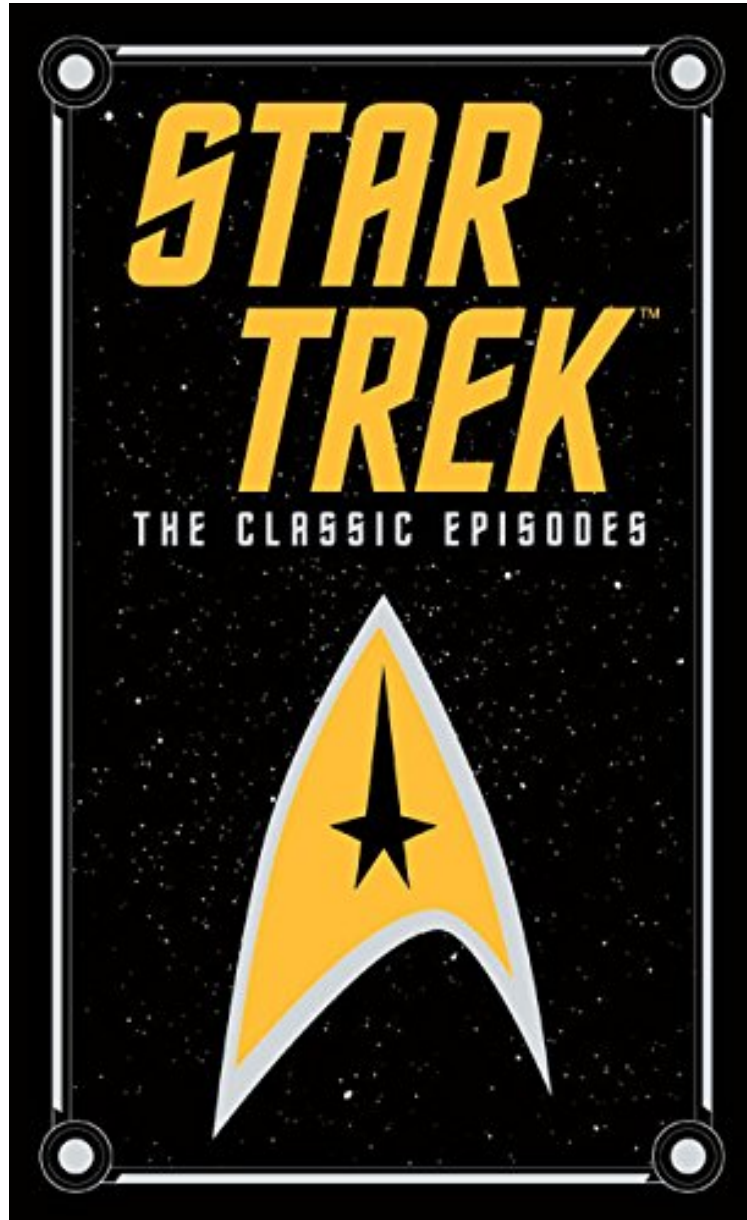

This book is as beautiful as many of the other books in the Barnes and Nobles classic library series, and every science fiction fan (Trekkie or not) should have it; this is a far more seminal sci-fi history collection than, say, the STAR WARS adaptations (they aren't bad, just can't compete). However, it is a criminal shame that the publishers did not imprint the name of the author, James Blish (with contributions from his wife, JA Lawrence) on the cover; both are mentioned on a sticky tab that was added to the back for the 50th Anniversary copies, and the full details of their involvement are sketched out within, although most Trekker's already know the whole story. Each episode is adapted as a short story and the teleplay writers are fully credited within. Be advised that this is only HALF of Blish's adaptations, and if enough people buy copies, we will likely see a volume 2, hopefully with both MUDD'S ANGELS and SPOCK MUST DIE included (it might be the publisher's are hoping to pad it out to three volumes).
