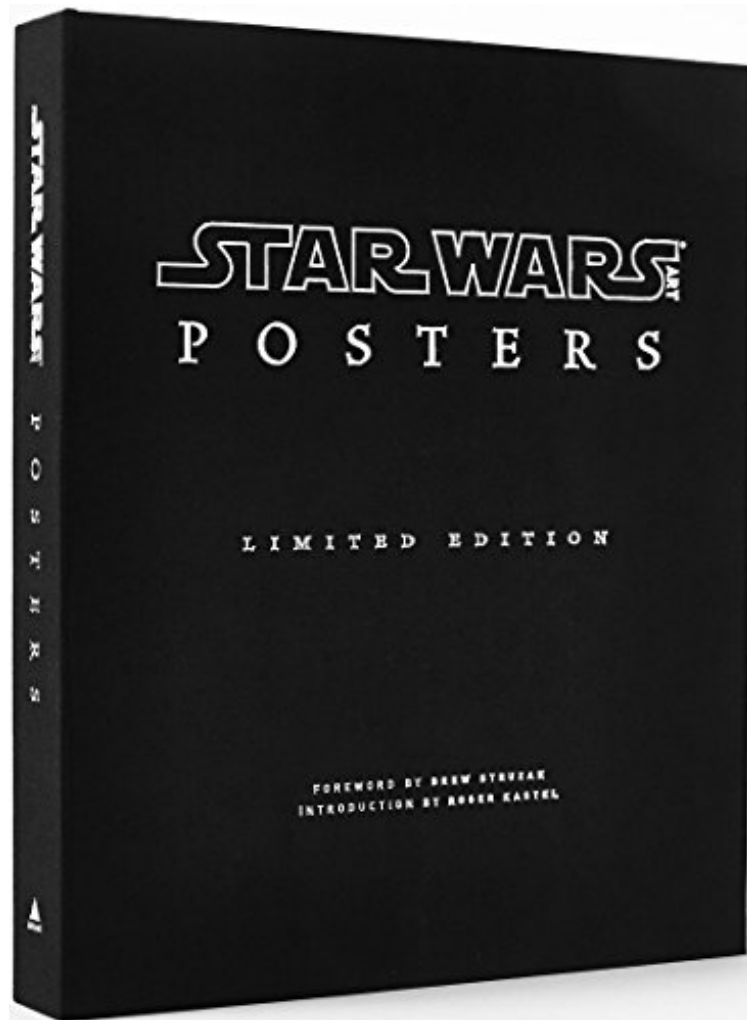

Some of the photos on the page don't do it justice and are somewhat confusing. It gives the impression that even though this is a limited edition, it has the same coloured cover as the much cheaper standard version of book...but then other pictures show the same book with a black cover...which is it?? Well, I'm very glad I purchased it as all became clear once opened the package.The very large and heavy book comes in it's own beautifully minimalistic black cloth bound case -which looks like the book itself standing upright in the photos- but it's not. No, this sturdy case opens up to house the hardcover edition of the Posters book sitting within in the same black cloth cover which make it look almost like the monolith from 2001: A Space Odyssey!It is simply a gorgeous book to own as a collector's item. With it, there is also an envelope containing some high quality prints signed by the artists as a bonus. It appears that there are only 325 of these limited edition versions available so I can only see this tome as highly sought after and highly desirable in the near future.Grab it while you still can!
