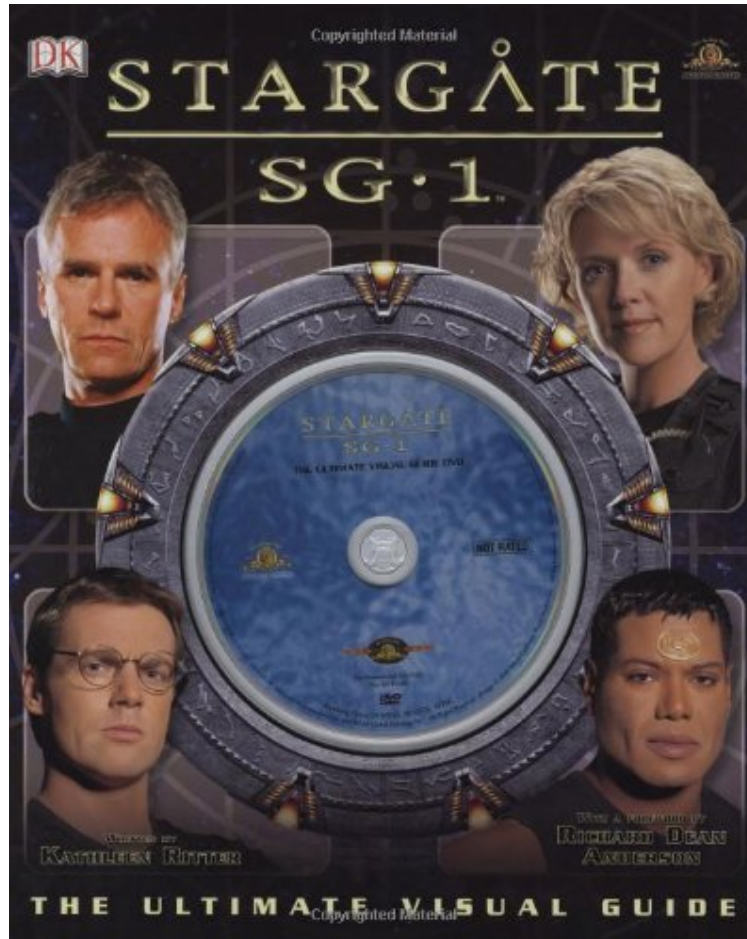

There are also useful plot and arc summaries along with season summaries to help understand the series or fill in gaps for those that may have missed sections. However, as a fan and someone who

is making costumes and props, I found the book a bit lacking in detail and clean, concise images of various items and uniforms. There's a hodgepodge of useful stuff, but it only scratches the surface in the amount of detail that the studio and writers poured into this series. The book could have easily been three times larger, and I was hoping it would have been. I have not checked out the included CD/DVD disc yet, however.
