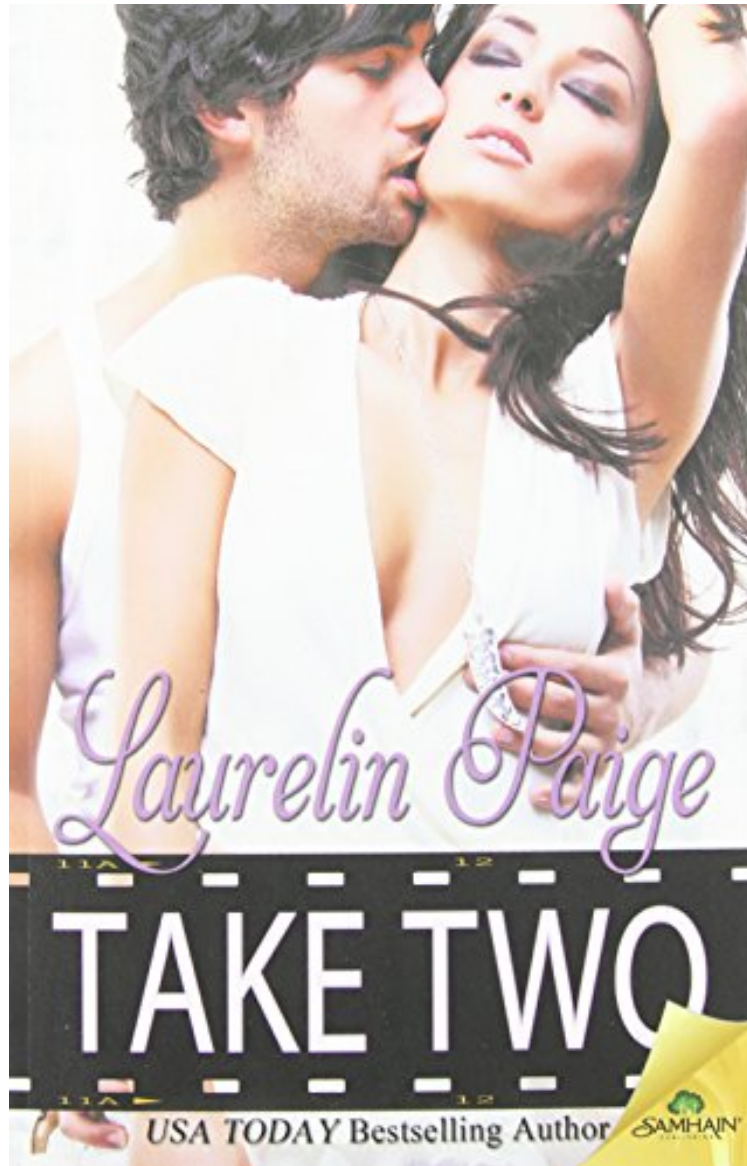

In fact, I kept checking to make sure it was by the same author. Im not knocking the author for

that. I see no point in writing the same book over and over (cough- Maya Banks- cough) but you need to be aware up front that this is not like Fixed. That being said lets start with the positive things: The book is well written with a decent edit job; The story line is pretty decent; The romance seems authentic enough; There are some decent (though not stellar) steamy scenes. Im giving this book just the ok rating because: The female H was annoying. Her constant crying was distracting and didnt necessarily fit the description of her character. There isnt a lot of depth to the story.
