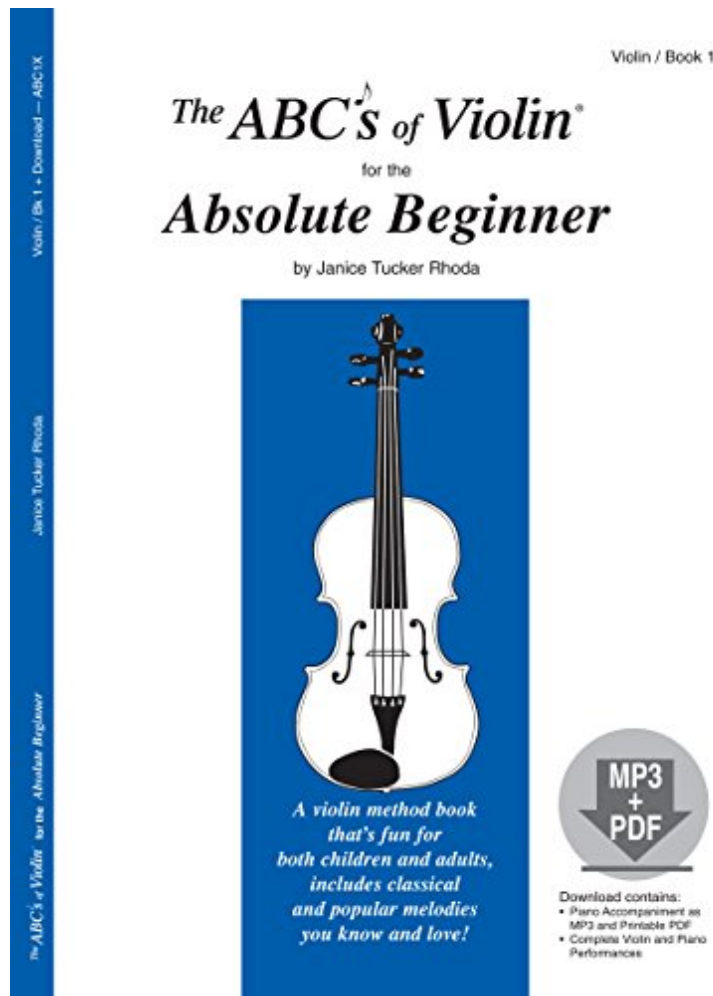

I played the first couple of months holding the bow completely wrong until a friend of mine showed how to hold it properly. As for learning the notes and fingers, the diagrams were a bit tricky but did the job. I'd suggest the book essential elements violin 1 book.
