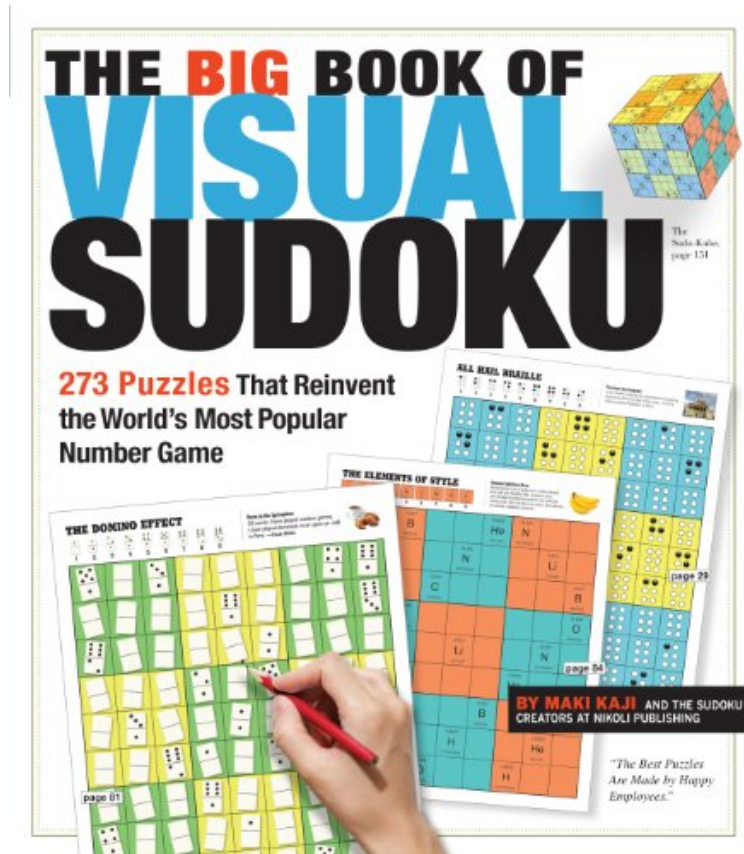

On closer inspection the only difference is the substitution of other symbols for ordinary numbers. Since I was already doing another book I put this off temporarily. It seems like a distraction from ordinary Sudoku.
