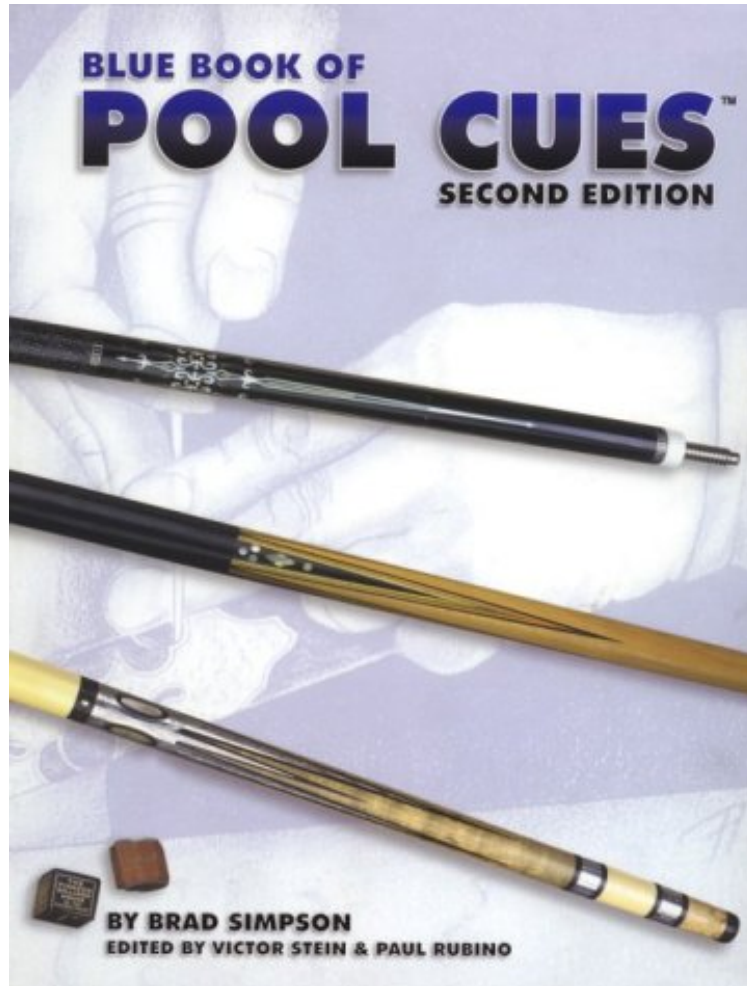

Their current
