I am 56 years old and have followed TOP since I was sixteen. The sound, the phrasing that Dave Garibaldi's book "The code of Funk" teaches is nothing short of amazing! In order to use the book, you should already have a good feeling for reading drum music, and have a free interpretational spirit of playing style.
