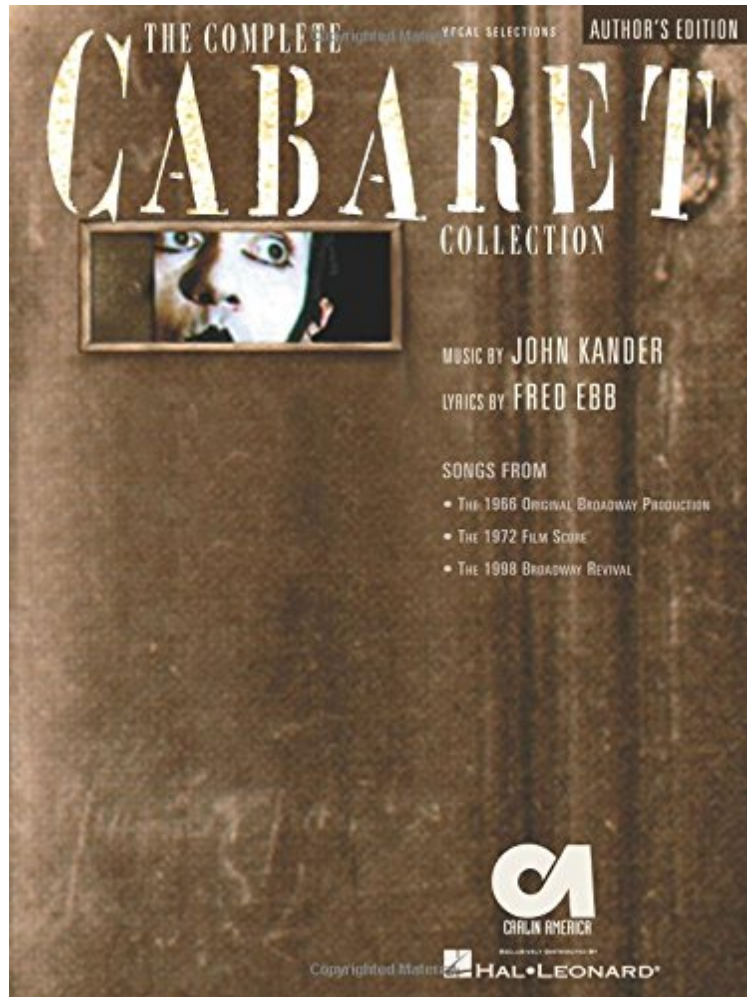

I primarily bought the book for the outtakes and the songs from the original Broadway musical. For its completeness, I give it 5 stars. The standards are there, of course, but those songs appear in

tons of compilations. I was more interested in songs like Good time Charlie and the Telephone Song. I'm always disappointed that vocal collections drop out everything but the hits of the show, and I was pleasantly surprised that this one didn't. I have an old copy of the Cabaret movie vocal selections book, and there's no comparison. This is the better book, hands down. However, I only played through it a few times, but didn't spend the time to compare with the score to see how much is a literal transcription versus a watered down version. Regardless, Maybe this Time is in a higher key than normal, which didn't bother me, but that does mean that some of the keys are different. One tiny complaint - if you want the German lyrics for "Tomorrow Belongs to Me," it's not there. However, my edition DOES contain I Don't Care Much. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
