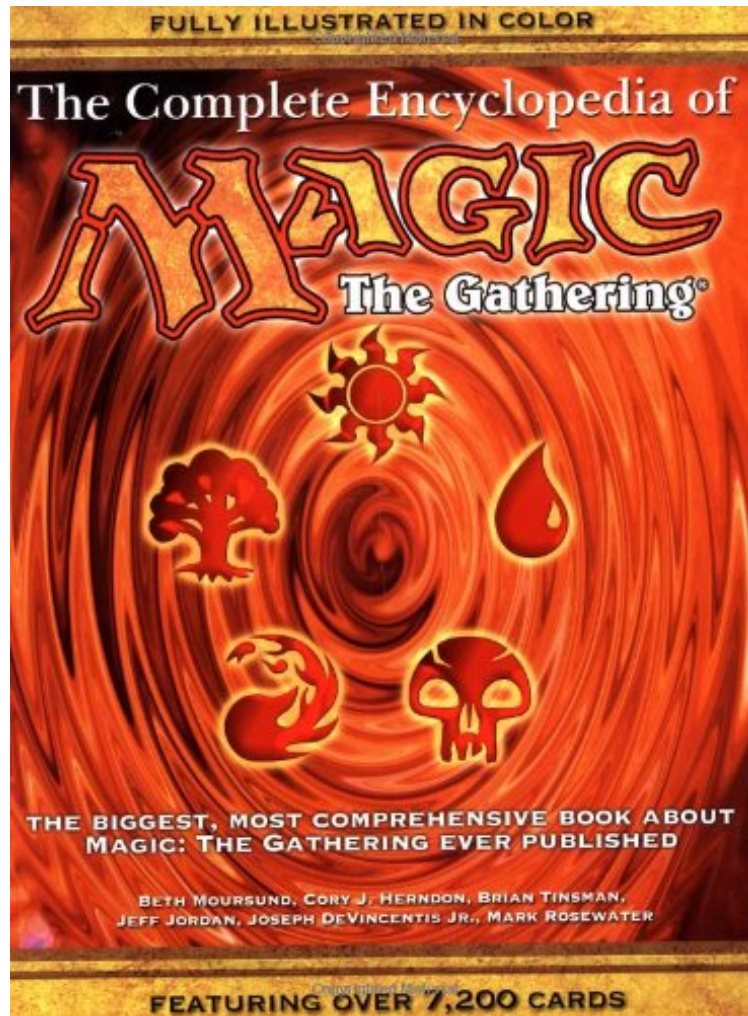

This is a compilation of earlier Magic: The Gathering encyclopedias. It contains full color images of every card up to and including 7th edition and the Invasion block sets. As other reviewers have pointed out, no attempt was made to edit the separate earlier encyclopedias into a single consistent presentation, and there are some glitches here and there. For some of the earlier sets, the card images don't have very good contrast, making the text a little hard to read. Still, I am delighted to have this book. I already had the card encyclopedias from all the more recent sets that come with the fat packs, and with this book I now have a complete reference for all the cards in the game. Yes, the information is all available through the online data base on the Magic website, but I am the sort of person who likes to just sit down with a book and browse to get ideas.
