Sam has several points of advice that I haven't encountered anywhere else, and I have read a lot of books on craps. Sam has what I consider a unique way of managing your bank roll by using what he calls the

"lock up" rack for profits on bets that are won. He also promotes giving your chips the best chance to win since you came there to gamble. He describes 12 plays for right bettors and 7 plays for wrong bettors. Depending on your style of play and your risk level, anyone can find one or two systems that will work for them here. This is not a "beginners" book and requires you understand the table layout and placing your bets correctly. One of his best pieces of advice is to "limit your losses, not your wins!" I have played craps for years, and realized after reading Sam's book that indeed I have limited my wins by playing to a win percentage. It takes some practice to understand his playing and money management style, but if you do your homework and find one of his plays that you like, I don't think you will be disappointed.
