This compendium of the biography, history and lore of the world of magic should appeal to practitioners and magic enthusiasts alike. It contains over 1000 fully cross-referenced entries of the most popular and lesser known magical tricks, and explains which magician made each trick famous.

From Library JournalWritten by a magician, this is a historical encyclopedia of magicians and their magic effects, paraphernalia, and terms. Entries are quite short for the most part, and treatment is uneven. Only 19 words, for example, are devoted to "sleight-of-hand," and only twice that many to the "American Museum of Magic." "Firewalk," on the other hand, takes up an entire column with considerable historical background included. There are more than 2000 entriesmany containing references to previous literatureand numerous cross-references. Most larger public libraries will want to consider for their reference collections.
